The company maintains certified trainers for IPC-A-610 and IPC J- STD-001, enabling standardized training and certification activities to be conducted internally while ensuring employees remain aligned with evolving industry requirements and customer expectations.

In addition, employees have achieved IPC Wire Harness Assembly and Inspection certifications, supporting the company's growing expertise in cable and wire harness manufacturing. Through regular refresher programmes and ongoing professional development, IPC certification is treated not as a one-time achievement but as part of a broader commitment to technical excellence.
